Current Rule: **FRAMES 9.7.1** Major components may not be newer than the cutoff date specified for a class (e.g., no inverted forks in the vintage or Vintage Superbike classes).

Proposed Change: add “post-period” to the parenthetical clause so it reads:

Major components may not be newer than the cutoff date specified for a class (e.g., no post-period inverted forks in the vintage or Vintage Superbike classes).

Discussion: This is a minor clarification as there were inverted telescopic forks in use during the 1950/60s (e.g. Moto Guzzi). While not very likely, someone could legally use those period inverted tele forks on later motorcycles.
